OPTIONAL CAPE TOWN PRE TRAIN or POST TRAIN TOUR

DAY 1	
	You will be met on arrival at Cape Town International Airport or Platform 24 Cape Town Station by a representative of African Welcome Safaris and transferred to the Cape Grace on the V & A Waterfront for three night stay on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis. An À la Carte menu is available for dinner at the hotel restaurant to the value of R300 per person per night. Beverages are for your own account.
DAY 2 – FULL DAY WINELANDS TOUR	
09h30	<p>Depart for full day tour of the wine-lands. Visit the historical town of Stellenbosch the second oldest settlement in the Cape renowned for its well preserved architecture spanning three centuries. After a brief town tour we take you into the mysteries of winemaking at the <i>Bergkelder</i> (the cellar in the mountain) Cellar with ample with the opportunity to taste and purchase wines.</p> <p>We then head over the Helshoogte Mountain pass to Franschhoek, the valley settled by the French Huguenots in the latter 17th Century. Lunch and a wine tasting will be enjoyed at the Chamonix Restaurant and Wine Estate. After lunch we make our way to Paarl, stopping at Seidelberg Wine Estate which, with its spectacular views, sets the scene for a unique wine tasting experience. Visit the on-site Venetian style glass blowing studio, Red Hot Glass, and watch one of oldest crafts on earth as the artists create stunning masterpieces.</p> <p>The tour continues to the town of Paarl, set beneath distinctive granite mountains. After a further wine estate visit and a tour of this small rural town it's time to head back to the City of Cape Town and the Cape Grace where you will overnight.</p>
DAY 3 – FULL DAY CAPE PENINSULA TOUR	
09h00	<p>Depart for full day tour of Cape Peninsula (please take warm clothing and comfortable shoes). Our first stop is Rhodes Memorial with its magnificent views and then on to the world renowned Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens for a guided tour. We head for False Bay and visit the Jackass Penguin Colony at Boulders Beach and enjoy a seafood lunch at The Black Marlin restaurant. In the early afternoon we enter the 8500ha Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve which hosts 7 Species of antelope including the Eland, Bontebok and the rare Cape Mountain Zebra. We continue down to Cape Point, the most south westerly point of Africa (18° east lat. and 34° south long.) In the late afternoon we return via the scenic <i>Ou Kaapse Weg</i> (Old Cape Way) back to the City for dinner and overnight at the Cape Grace Hotel.</p>
DAY 4 – ROVOS RAIL/CAPE TOWN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT	
09h45	Transfer from the Cape Grace to the Rovos Rail Lounge at No 1 Adderley Street (opposite the Cape Town Railway Station) for an 11h00 departure onboard Rovos Rail or to Cape Town International Airport for your flight home.

08h30	Following breakfast guests will be met at the hotel by a representative from Zanzibar Unique and transferred to the Zanzibar International Airport. Depart on a Coastal Aviation Flight for Dar es Salaam.
09h30	On arrival at Dar es Salaam guests will be met by a Rovos Rail representative whereupon you will be re-united with your stored luggage.
10h40	Guests will then be transferred to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tazara Railway Station for check-in on Rovos Rail or - The International Terminal for their outbound flight or - to a Dar es Salaam Hotel as per their onward itinerary.

The Serena Inn Hotel

In the heart of the legendary Stone Town of Zanzibar stands the Zanzibar Serena Inn, a member of Small Luxury Hotels. Two historic seafront buildings have been masterfully restored to their original splendour, to create this property. The luxury air-conditioned guest rooms have en suite showers, hair dryer, television, a fully stocked mini bar, as well as direct dial telephone.

The hotel offers a full service lounge and bar with one main restaurant, where the team of chefs create superb meals and, as with most coastal venues, seafood is a specialty and an absolute must on the menu. The Hotel also boasts a swimming pool, coffee shop, curio shop, and business centre. With Stone Town's rich cultural heritage, the Serena is able to offer a variety of optional daytrips including round the island tours in native sailing dhows, scuba diving and snorkelling.

Historical Stone Town Tour

This tour starts at the main city market which was opened in 1904 and sells tropical fruits, vegetables, spices and fresh fish from the island. The next stop will be at the Anglican Church of Christ, which was built by Bishop Steere in 1873 on the site of the old slave market. Next to the church you will visit the slave chambers, tiny rooms in which the slaves were kept before being auctioned. From here continue to the Sultan's Palace Museum and House of Wonders as well as the Old Fort. Then it's on to The Africa house, formerly an English Club and come to Tippu Tip house, home of the notorious slave trader. Other sites include the Museum of Natural History and the Peach Memorial Museum. Your tour ends as you walk through the narrow streets of the town discovering exotic bazaars, antique and curio shops.

Zanzibar Spice Tour

Also known as the "Island of Spices", Zanzibar evokes a romantic past embalmed in the aroma of cloves, cinnamon, cardamom and lemon grass. This tour meanders through a profusion of greenery in the countryside seeing, smelling and tasting a variety of mouth watering tropical seasonal fruits including jackfruit, pineapple, green coconut and many others. A full tour involves much more than spices. You will have a chance to see the Iodine plant, henna bush, ylang-ylang, the lipstick tree, cocoa and coffee trees. The tour includes a visit to the Kidichi Persian Baths built in 1850 by Seyyid Said Bin Sultan for his Persian wife, Princess Sheherezade, granddaughter of the Shah of Persia. Also included is a visit to the ruins of the Maruhubi Palace, built by the third Sultan of Zanzibar Seyyid Barghash for his 99 concubines.

Cancellation Insurance

It is highly recommended that cancellation insurance is taken out as our terms and conditions will be strictly adhered to and cancellation fees, where applicable, will not be waived.

Dress

During the day, the dress is smart casual. Attire that is more formal is worn in the evening. A collar & tie is a minimum requirement, please.

With regard to the off-train excursions: It can get very cold during the game drives (open vehicles) and the Sunset Cruise on the Zambezi River, therefore warm clothing is strongly recommended. The excursion to Chisimba Falls involves some walking so comfortable walking shoes; sun tan lotion and hats are strongly recommended.

Currency

In South Africa one can only make use of South African Rand. All major credit cards (Master Card, Visa, American Express and Diners Club) are accepted.

For Zimbabwe, no credit cards should be used and it is suggested that all payments to be made in LOW denomination US Dollar notes. Any off-train expenses to be paid with US Dollar banknotes (low denomination).

Standard Chartered Bank **Zimbabwe** has made a decision to pull out of MasterCard acquiring on the Point of Sale (POS) in Zimbabwe with effect from 01st January, 2007, due to prohibitive investments costs. Therefore, all hotels in Zimbabwe will no longer accept MasterCard transactions with effect from 01st January, 2007: Only VISA, DINERS and AMEX cards will be acceptable.

In June 2008, Zimbabwean Banks suspended all credit card transactions until they can introduce new systems, as their equipment is no longer able to handle the billions of local currency involved in even the smallest of transactions. This will remain the case until further notice.

Zambia and Tanzania, it is best to make use of US Dollars in cash form (hotels and major dealers will also accept credit cards).

On Board Services

A Medical Practitioner, Hair Stylist & Historian accompany the train at various stages.

Cuisine and Ambience

Breakfast, lunch and a formal dinner are served in one sitting only in the charming Victorian atmosphere of the Dining Cars – meals, carefully prepared, are complemented by a selection of fine South African wines. Meals can be adapted to suit special requirements by prior arrangement.

The Observation Car seats 32 passengers and takes up the rear end of the train. The coach next to it contains a smoking lounge which seats eight. At the centre of the train we have, when numbers dictate, a non-smoking Lounge Car, which seats 26 passengers in comfort. In maintaining the spirit of travel of a bygone era, there are no radios or television sets onboard and the use of cellular telephones is confined to the privacy of the suites.

Laundry

There is a limited and simple laundry service on board comprising of household washers, dryers and steam irons. The turn around is 48 hours so the staff would not be able to handle a week's worth of washing. Please advise your hostess if your clothing needs specialist attention.

Rovos Rail Memorabilia

There is a small gift shop on board and at our station premises at Capital Park in Pretoria. Due to the varying exchange rates, the use of credit cards is preferred. Cash (South African Rand) is also accepted.
